QUICK FACTS

- GiveNOLA Day is a 24-hour online giving event hosted by the Greater New Orleans Foundation.
- It's Tuesday, May 5, from 12:01 AM to Midnight.
- It's a day when everyone can be a philanthropist by making a donation for as little as \$10 to over 500 participating nonprofits.
- Last year, our inaugural year, we raised an astonishing \$2.2 million from more than 19,000 individuals for the 300 participating nonprofits.
- This year's goal is to raise \$3 million from 25,000 participants for our 574 participating nonprofits.
- Thanks to our generous sponsors, we've raised over \$370,000 to make the day more fun.
- Every donation is stretched further because participating nonprofits receive a proportional gift from the Lagniappe Fund. Additionally, prizes are awarded to nonprofits that raise the most money and receive the most gifts, and, Rock-Around-the-Clock Prizes are awarded randomly every hour.

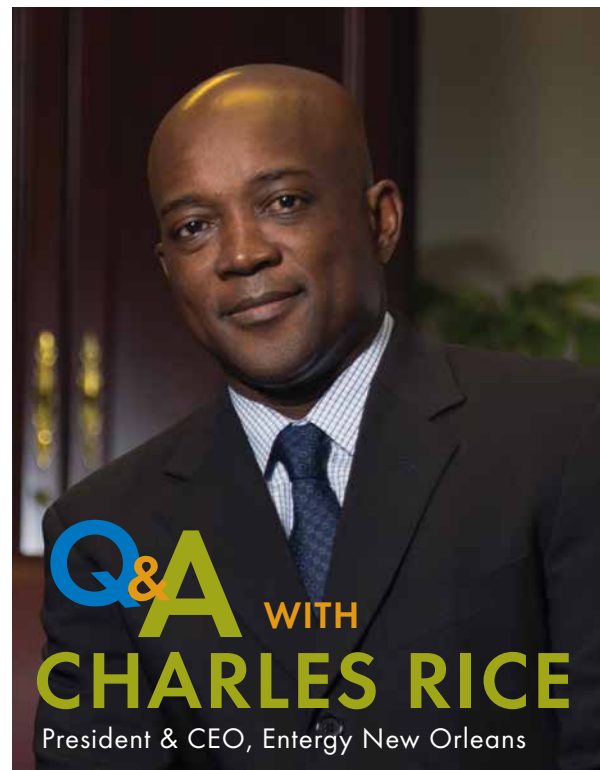
